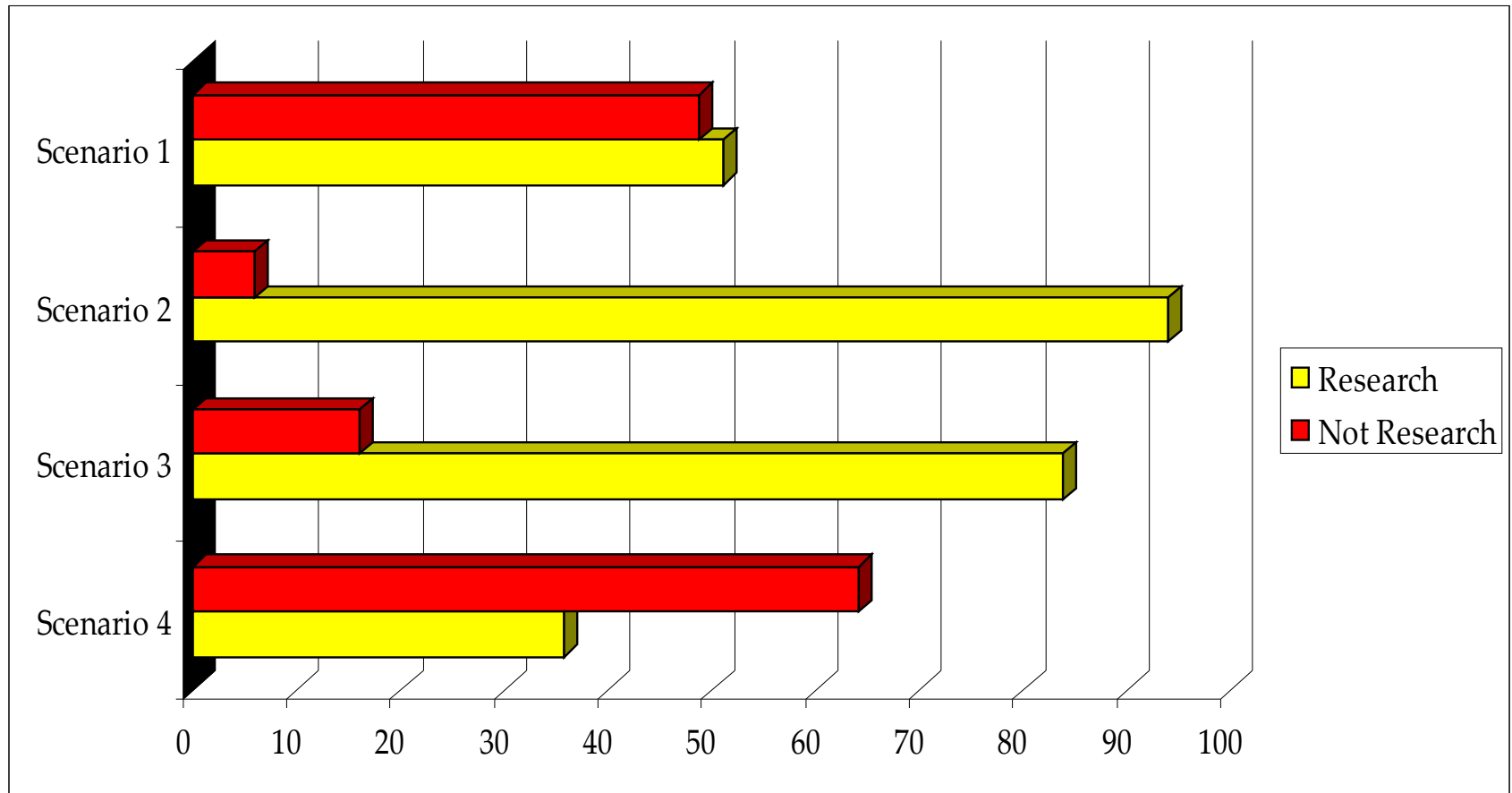

- Public

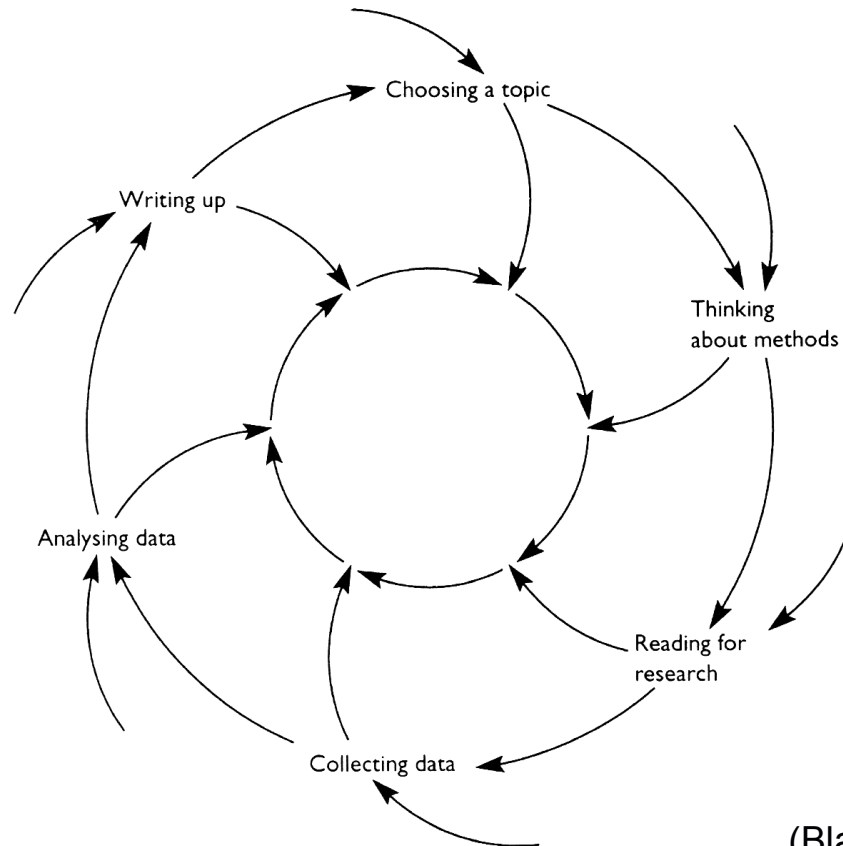
## Why Do Research?

- to find better ways of teaching.
- because it is good for my professional development.
- to solve problems in my professional work.

## Varieties of Research

- **Classroom research** – conducted in classrooms (where?)
- **Teacher research** – conducted by teachers (by whom?) to explore some aspect of their own context (why?)
- **Action research** – using a particular methodology (how?)

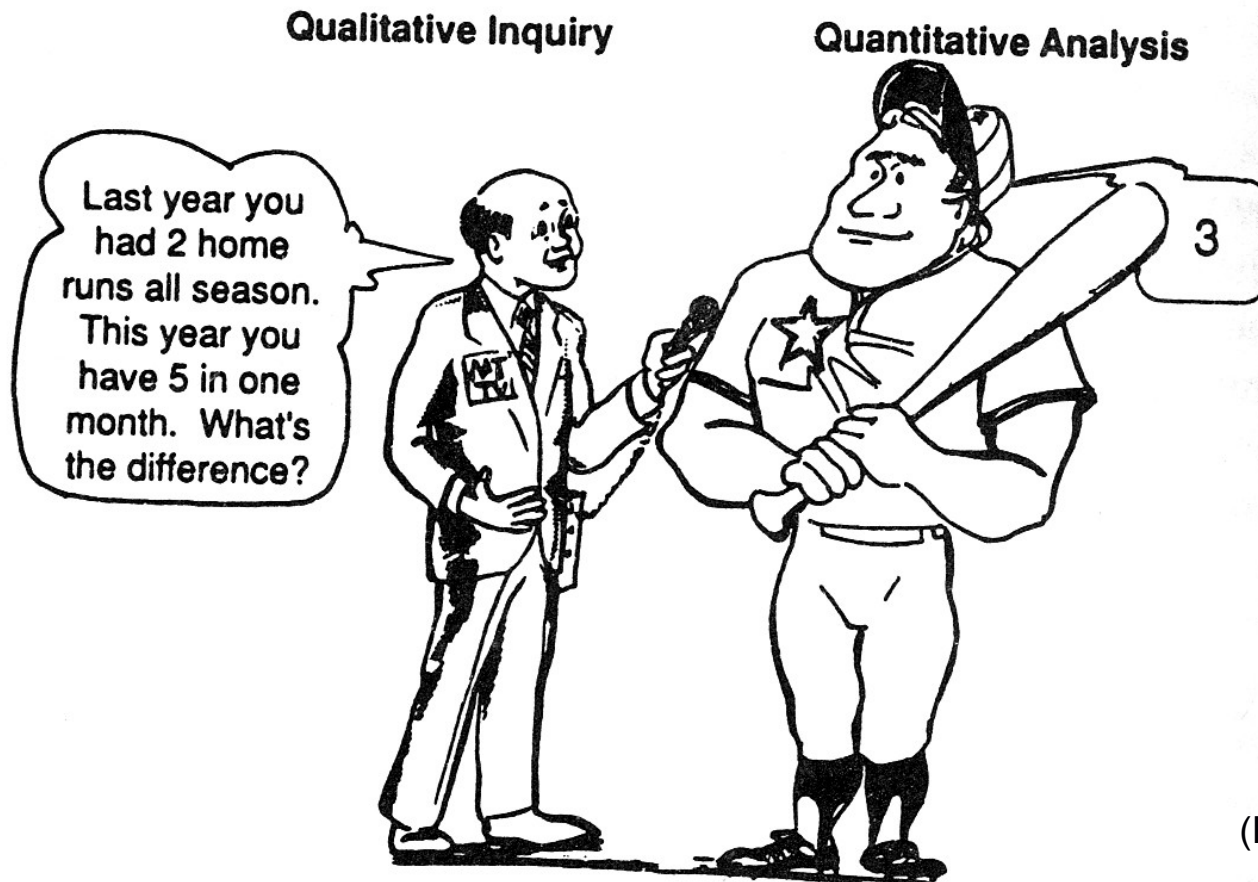
## Research Questions
